The Volunteer LGBTQ Sexual Health OUTreach Specialist is responsible for conducting outreach in the community to promote the Family Tree Clinic LGBTQ Sexual Health Program.

- Participate in initial and ongoing training on various sexual health topics.
- Provide outreach in the community at various LGBTQ events, including distributing Safer Sex Kits, sexual health information, and Family Tree program materials.
- Participate in monthly Outreach Team meetings.

An interest in and dedication to Reproductive Justice and LGBTQ sexual health care. Ability to commit to shifts and keep the commitment.

The Volunteer LGBTQ Sexual Health Outreach Specialist reports to the Education and Support Coordinator.
