Surgeries/Medical Care

- [Point of Pride](https://pointofpride.org) (pointofpride.org):
 - [Annual Transgender Surgery Fund](#): Scholarship-like program that provides direct financial assistance to trans folks who cannot afford their gender-affirming surgery.
 - [Electrolysis Support Fund](#): Financial assistance towards permanent hair removal services (including electrolysis and laser hair removal) for trans folks who cannot otherwise afford them.
 - [HRT Access Fund](#): Direct financial assistance for HRT.
 - [Thrive Fund](#): Small grants to trans folks who cannot afford gender-affirming health and wellness services that fall outside of our existing programs. For example, wigs, fees for name changes, caregivers after surgery, waxing, voice therapy.
 - [Free Chest Binders](#) and [Free Femme Shapewear](#): specially designed, gender-affirming compression garments for any trans person who needs one they cannot afford or safely obtain.

Applicants do not have to be Jewish and can be moving from any state in the U.S. to any state in the U.S. (but not outside of the country).
